- Bursary Schemes in Drogheda, Cork, Belfast, Waterford, Derry & Dublin.
- Several Erasmus+ projects being run each year.
- 1 small vessel Brian Boru
- Strong relationships with foreign vessels such as Maybe, Pelican, Morgenster & Others.
- Excellent network of nominating organisations to assist trainee recruitment.

## Trainee Recruitment

- Not a case of "Build it and they will come".
- Focus on 15-30 years
- Through youth and community organisations "Nominating Organisations"
  - They act as referee (they know their youths)
  - ► They support fundraising and preparation
  - ► They liaise with parents/guardians
- ▶ This enables us to access those most in need of support
- We provide a briefing/orientation
- We coordinate travel
- HUGE IMPACT



### Erasmus +

- EU funding via Leargas.
- Youth Exchange projects between young people from two or more EU Countries-Youth exchange and Mobility of Youth.
- ► Funding of €49 per day per trainee plus a travel allowance.
- Excellent education program run on board.
- ▶ A theme for each project i.e. Employability.
- Run by Youth Leaders / Mentors
- Onerous Reporting requirements
- Careful -- Change in Funding cashflow.

## **Bursary Schemes**

- ► Local trainees, vessels, sponsors, councils & ports
- Key relationship between Port company and Council who provide initial funding.
- Local Corporate sponsors
- Festivals / Events
- ▶ STIRL coordinating it all
- Key to success is local person who gets what we are about and the impact it can have.
- Progression from local voyages to Erasmus plus offshore voyages & Tall Ships Races
