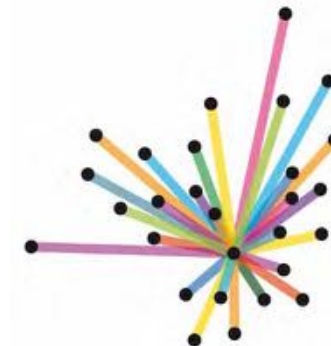

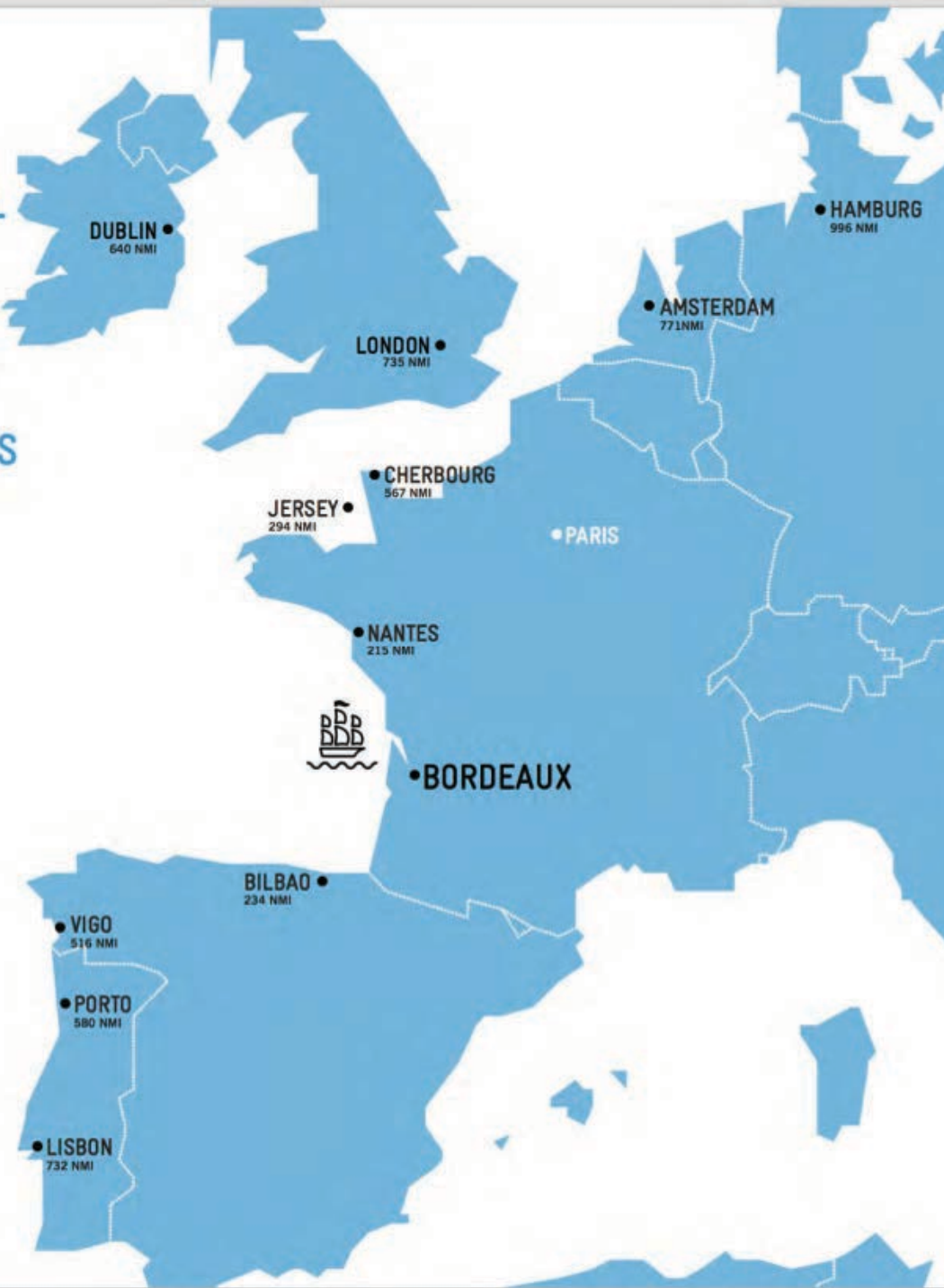

Liverpool

- Previous history of holding the Tall Ships Races in 1984, 1992 and also its year as European Capital of Culture in 2008
- Also hosted the Tall Ships Regatta in 2012

3 Festivals Tall Ships Regatta 2018

- 17 Ships initially but unfortunately 2 ships pulled out close to the event because of technical issues
- Supplemented by 9 'Nobby' boats - Morecombe Bay Prawners

- 41 Sail Trainees from differing backgrounds including apprentices, university students and hard to reach

- Ships were berthed at the Royal Albert Dock and the Cruise Liner Berth
- Wirral was a partner for the Parade of Sail day



3 Festivals Tall Ships Regatta 2018

- Event was supported by the Royal Navy with the presence of HMS Somerset an Type 23 Frigate
- This was the only public event in the UK that the Royal Navy supported in 2018



3 Festivals Tall Ships Regatta 2018

- 3 deck parties were hosted on board the *MS Morgenster*, two of which were day sails
- *La Malouine* was chartered for each day of the event and used as a stage to host bands as part of the Irish Theme on the Royal Albert Dock

As part of the overall event Liverpool hosted an element of the Bordeaux Wine Festival within the event footprint on the Waterfront

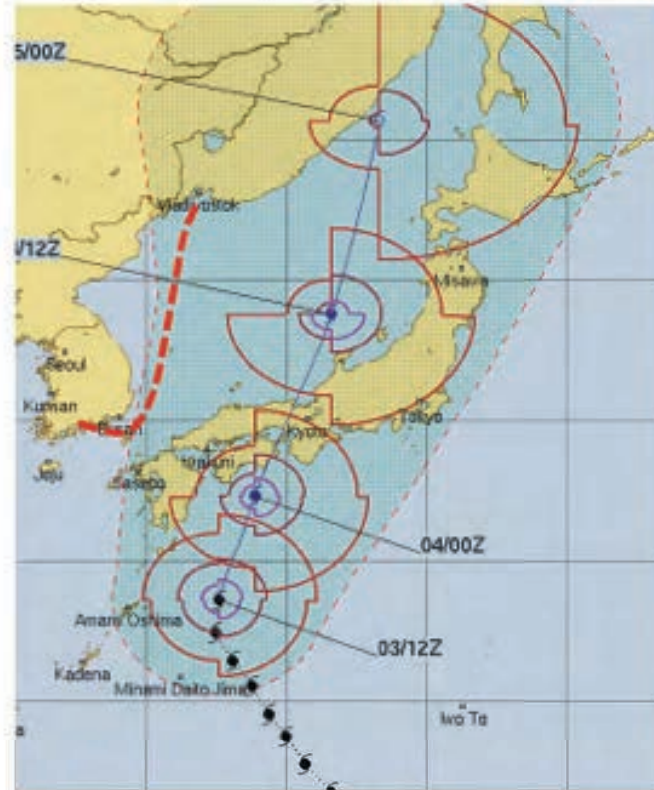

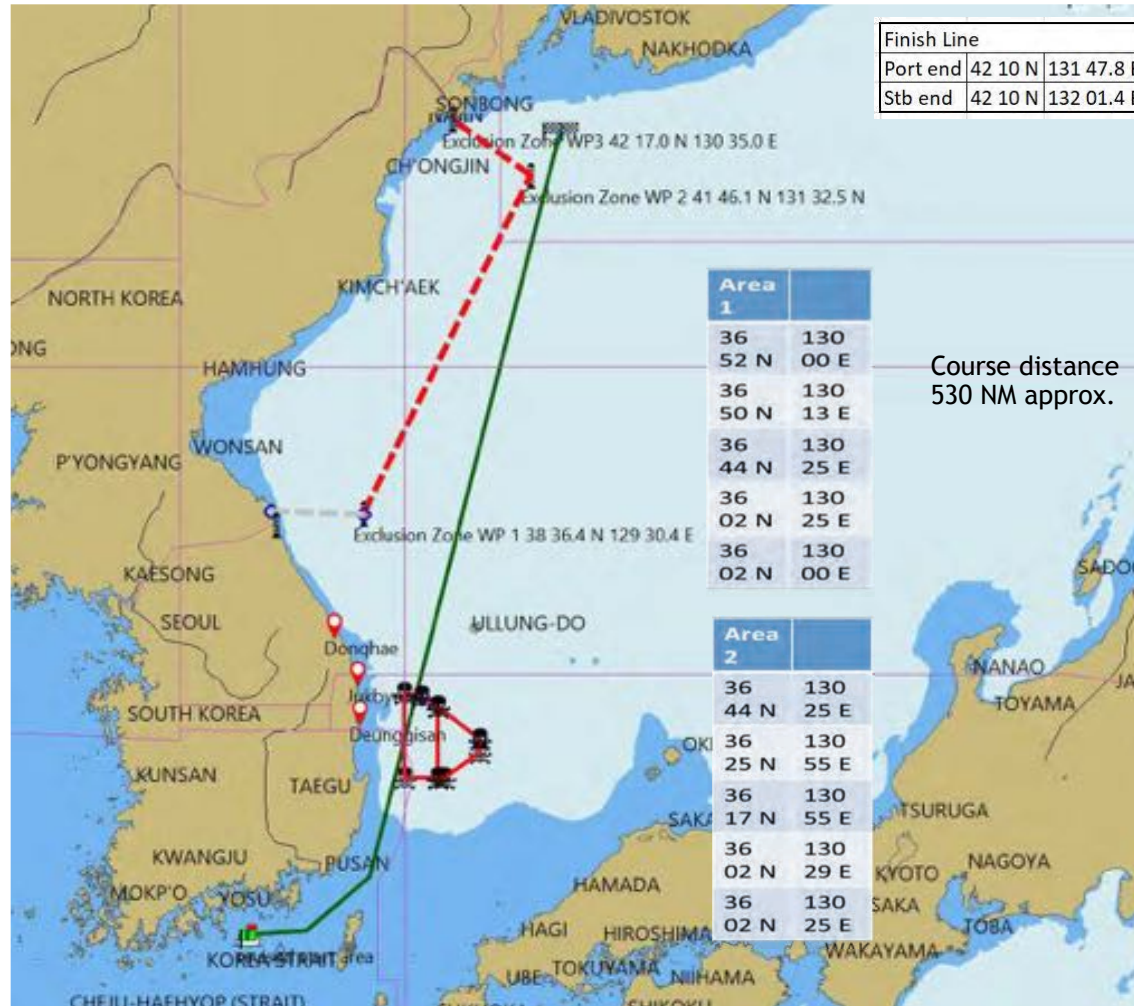

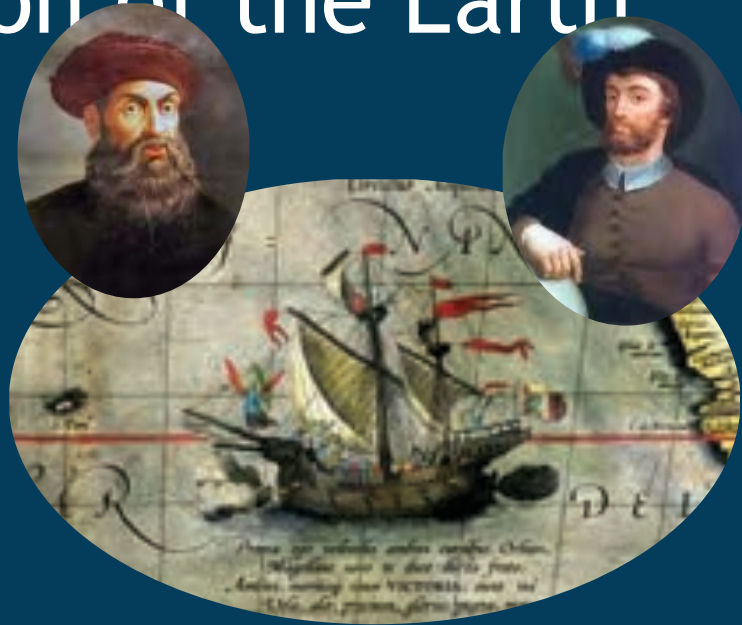
Spain celebrates 500th anniversary of first circumnavigation of the Earth



Three-year programme of activities mirroring the three years the Magellan-Elcano voyage took to complete (from 1519 to 1522).

The programme is meant to **tell the story of the expedition in Spain and the world**, drawing attention to its importance and to the explorers behind the big deed.

The **5th Centennial National Commission** was created by a Royal Decree-law in 2017. The Commission is **in charge of planning, developing, and executing programs, projects, and activities to commemorate** the centennial of 1st circumnavigation around the globe
